

Cedarhurst Visitation Policy



Visits May Occur:

- Outdoors whenever possible
- In dedicated indoor visitation spaces
- In private resident apartments; or
- In shared apartments provided that only one resident can have visitors at a time in-apartment without the roommate present if possible, and core principles of infection control are maintained



Visitation Guidelines

- Full vaccination for visitors is preferred but it is not required
- All visitors must complete the signs & symptoms screening, including temperature checks, upon entering the community
- May have a rapid COVID-19 test administered upon arrival at the community, if desired.
- Visitors should wear a face mask that covers their mouth and nose, and practice proper cough etiquette
- Hand hygiene should be performed by the resident and the visitors before and after each visit
- Visitors must keep at least a 6-foot separation between themselves, and other visitors, staff, and residents and visitors must
- During indoor visitation, visitors should limit movement in the community. Please go directly to the resident's apartment or designated visitation area
- Notify Cedarhurst if visitor develops signs or symptoms of COVID-19 within three days after visiting or tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days after visiting
- All those ages 2+ will be required to wear facial masks and adhere to the visitation guidelines above. Those who do not cooperate may have their visit ended.

The community will follow guidance from state and local authorities on when visitation should be temporarily paused for high-risk circumstances of COVID-19 transmission.



Outdoor Visitation

Residents either in quarantine or positive with Covid-19 should not participate in outdoor visits until they have met criteria to be released from quarantine or discontinue isolation precautions.



Vaccination Status Modifications

Fully Vaccinated Residents

- › While alone in the resident's apartment or in the designated visitation area, the resident and their visitor(s) may choose to have close contact (including touch) and NOT wear a facial mask.
- › Visitors should wear facial mask and physically distance from staff and other residents and visitors that are not part of their group at all other times while in the community.

Non-Vaccinated Residents and/or Visitors Not Fully Vaccinated

- › Must wear a facial mask whenever outside of their apartments within the community and maintain physical distance of 6-feet or more from other residents and visitors.
- › However, if the resident is fully vaccinated, they may choose to have close contact (including touch) with their unvaccinated visitor(s) while both continue to wear well-fitting facial masks.
