Dear Residents, Families & Friends:

Cedarhurst Senior Living's Coronavirus (COVID-19) Response Team has been closely monitoring the quickly evolving news and information about the spread of COVID-19. Numerous State and Federal health officials have given guidance for all senior living communities to cancel all group activities and communal dining. To adhere to their guidance, effective today, and until further notice, we will be offering ONLY in-room dining services to our residents.

I know that previously we issued revised guidance on our dining rooms, but it is necessary in this situation to adapt quickly to a changing environment, including guidance from applicable healthcare authorities and regulators.

Any residents that need assistance or identified as having a risk of choking will continue to dine in the dining room during mealtimes. Those residents will be asked to dine at least six feet away from each other unless they cohabitate. We're taking this action in a proactive effort to safeguard the health and safety of our residents and staff. We believe that given the rapid spread of COVID-19, this action is prudent and necessary.

At the moment, we cannot say with any certainty how long this will be in effect. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and evaluate information and guidance provided by state and federal agencies to inform future decisions. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this time.
